

VETERINARY VACCINATIONS GUIDELINES



Stine Veterinary Hospital is dedicated to providing the highest quality care for your pet. We feel that following the proper vaccination schedule will extend the life of your pet.

Below you will find a comprehensive listing of the recommended vaccination schedule for dogs and cats according to their ages.

Before we at Stine Veterinary Hospital begin a vaccination or health care regimen for your pet, we consult with you to develop a specific plan of action tailored to meet your pet's needs. We enjoy having you as an active participant planning what is best for your pet's health.

Stine Veterinary Hospital's vaccination recommendations are based on the **American Animal Hospital Association's** vaccination guidelines.

Vaccination Guidelines for Puppies/Dogs Include:

8-9 weeks

Vaccination DA2PP #1 (Distemper, Adenovirus, Parainfluenza, Parvovirus)

11-12 weeks

Vaccination DA2PP #2 (Distemper, Adenovirus, Parainfluenza, Parvovirus) & Bordetella #1 (if your pet will be going to a groomer, dog park or boarding kennel)

15-16 weeks

Vaccination DA2PP #3 (Distemper, Adenovirus, Parainfluenza, Parvovirus), Bordetella #2 (if your pet will be doing to a groomer, dog park or boarding kennel) & Rabies (at 16 weeks)

Other Vaccines include Lymes, Rattle snake, Giardia, & Lepto. We will be happy to discuss these options with you and see if they are right for your pet.

Vaccination Guidelines for Kittens/Cats Include:

8-9 weeks

Feline Leukemia Virus (FeLV) and Feline Immunodeficiency Virus (FIV) **test**, FVRCP #1 - Panleukopenia (Distemper); Rhinotracheitis (Herpes); Calicivirus, FeLV #1 - Feline Leukemia

11-12 weeks

FVRCP #2 - Panleukopenia (Distemper); Rhinotracheitis (Herpes); Calicivirus, FeLV #2 - Feline Leukemia

15-16 weeks

FVRCP #3 - Panleukopenia (Distemper); Rhinotracheitis (Herpes); Calicivirus & Rabies (at 16 weeks)

Other Vaccines include FIP, FIV, & Bordetella. We will be happy to discuss these options with you and see if they are right for your pet.

Most Vaccinations are annual after the puppy/kitten series. Stine Veterinary Hospital recommends Spaying and Neutering your pet anytime after 4 months old depending on breed, weight, & health of your pet.
